The inaugural Samuel Ryder Tour will take place in early July 2013 when 12 – 20 lucky golfers will visit St. Albans, where Samuel Ryder lived for most of his life, compete in the Ryder Trophy at Verulam GC, his home club, as special guests of the club and then play six of the iconic courses in England that have hosted the Ryder Cup.

TOUR ITINERARY

Friday, July 5th

Depart U.S. for London.

Saturday, July 6th

Arrive London a.m., meet coach and driver and transfer to The Grove Hotel, a 5-star Golf Resort near St. Albans and London for four nights. Take the Samuel Ryder Trail and play this afternoon in the annual Ryder Trophy at Verulam Golf Club, Samuel Ryder's home club, as guests and compete for special guest prizes.

Sunday, July 7th

Play golf at Walton Heath, host club for the 1981 Ryder Cup matches.

Monday, July 8th

Play golf at Wentworth's West Course, host club for the 1953 Ryder Cup. Welcome dinner in the Hotel.

Tuesday, July 9th

Rest day for sightseeing in London or other attractions nearby, with optional golf at The Grove.

Wednesday, July 10th

Transfer to luxury 4-star Formby Hall Golf Resort for 4 nights and play the Brabazon Course at The Belfry, venue for the Ryder Cup on 4 occasions, on the way.

Thursday, July 11th

Play Royal Lytham & St. Annes, Open Championship venue and host of the Ryder Cup in 1961 and 1977.

Friday, July 12th

Play Royal Birkdale, another great Open Championship venue and host of the Ryder Cup in 1965 and 1969.

Saturday, July 13th

Play Southport & Ainsdale, host venue for the Ryder Cup matches in 1933 and 1937.

Sunday, July 14th.

Transfer to Manchester Airport for flights home.

COSTS

Double Occ.: US\$5,495.00

- Opportunity to extend the trip 3 – 4 additional days to take in the Yorkshire "Ryder Cup" experience of golf at Ganton, Lindrick and Moortown, the three courses in Yorkshire that have hosted the Ryder Cup matches in the past.

Notes:

1. Costs are based on US\$ exchange rate of \$1.56 = £1.00 and are good for the bandwidth of \$1.54 - \$1.58. Final price will be based on rate at final payment 60 days before date of travel.
2. All tee times and lodgings are subject to availability at time of booking. Early bookings will secure negotiated room upgrades at some of the hotels.
3. Deposit of \$2,000 per golfer /\$1,000 per non-golfer to secure booking.
4. Fees specifically exclude air fares, meals other than breakfast and listed dinners, caddie fees/buggies and gratuity to coach driver.
